

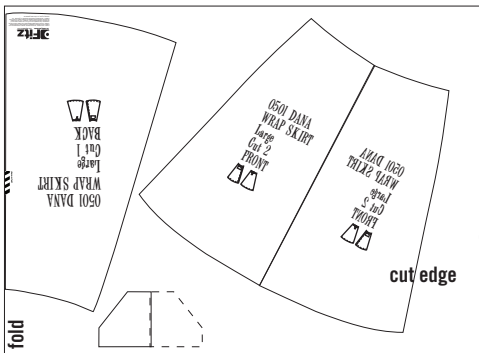
NO ZIPS, NO BUTTONS. JUST SEW IT UP AND IT'S A WRAP



1. Check your pattern has been printed to scale by measuring the test box is 10cm x 10cm (3 6/8"). Note that a seam allowance of 10mm (1cm or 3/8") has been allowed. In this pattern, the dotted line is the cutting line and the unbroken line is the stitching line.

2. Cut out pattern pieces from paper sheet. Try not to use your sewing shears as paper supposedly blunts their edge.

3. Layout and pin to fabric as per guide below. Cut out fabric following dotted line. You only need one of the pocket piece so cut it last when the fabric gets doubled.



4. Hem diagonal edged of pocket. Pin and sew to front.

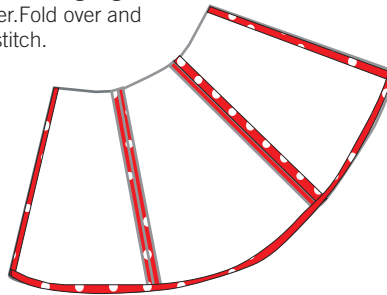


5. Put right sides of skirt together and sew. Press both sides of seams, and then press open. Finish edges.

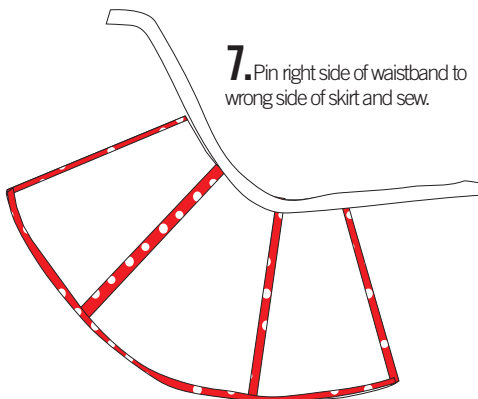


OSOD DANA WRAP SKIRT

6. Finish unjoined edges with zig zag or serger. Fold over and top stitch.



7. Pin right side of waistband to wrong side of skirt and sew.

place on fold

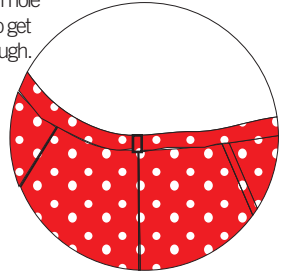

8. Fold over and tuck in edges. Sew.

9. Sew button hole large enough to get waistband through.



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
